How It Works

A single API connects you to AEB's SAP plug-ins, which integrate with your SAP system via an SAP transport. The integration takes place exclusively via the user exits and customer exits or Message Control in the SAP standard configuration, meaning that future updates require no additional effort. Data can be transferred by defined variants or full or delta transfer, with customisations possible using BAdIs. The table below provides an overview of tasks to be performed by an SAP administrator with access to the transport management system in SAP.

Phase	Description
Install plug-in	Download and install the SAP plug-in transports. Set up connections with the AEB tool.
Configure module	Configure settings within the plug-in to ensure the right actions are performed
Test module	Perform test of the setup and ensure the right results are coming out

Assumptions

- IT responsible/business process owner should have maximum rights in SAP to run all authorisations and transactions
- SAP_ALL and SAP_NEW authorisation objects should be assigned during the configuration process
- Access to the AEB cockpit is required
